Rev. Dr. Kathryn (Nichols) Campbell is elated to return to BRPC today and share in the leadership of our worship service! Kathryn grew up in our Church, was nurtured in our Sunday School, youth ministry, and choirs, served as youth elder, and is a Ridge High graduate. A few things have changed since she last sat in a BRPC pew on Christmas Eve 2003: after deciding athletic training wasn't for her, she attended Luther Seminary in St. Paul, MN, while working in Youth Ministry at Westminster Pres. in Minneapolis. Stephen Ministry presents "Connections Matter", an overview of the Adverse Childhood Experiences research with an emphasis on relationship building to help overcome and build healthier relationships which leads towards healing and stronger communities. This seminar will be led by Tracey Heisler, the Executive Director of the local Court Appointed Special Advocates program. She became involved with CASA as a volunteer in 1999 and fell in love with its child advocacy mission. Tracey is a graduate of the University of West Florida with a BA in Psychology (minors in Juvenile Justice and Forensics) and an MA in Counseling Psychology. She has previously worked with juvenile and adult offenders as well as child victims of abuse and neglect. She ensures that CASA SHaW's staff and advocates have the resources and tools they need to serve foster children in our community.
