During the week, our church office mirrors the Bernards Township public schools (bernardsboe.com). When they cancel school for the entire day, our church office will be closed, and all events are canceled. When they have a 2-hour delayed opening, so do we, and the church office opens at 11:00 a.m. When they have an early dismissal, we generally cancel afternoon and evening events.
